Dear Parents,

Thank you to those parents who attended the Y4 Sandymouth 2012 residential meeting last night. Following our presentation evening we are now ready to continue with our plans to visit a residential centre at Sandymouth Bay. It is our intention to take our Year 4 pupils on a residential course to Sandymouth Bay, from **Wednesday 30th May to Friday 1st June 2012**. It is well known that residential courses organized by schools are an invaluable part of a child's education and support them with developing their life skills. They offer new and exciting challenges and by living with their peers and working together in a team environment, help develop independence, confidence and an ability to recognize strengths and weaknesses in a constructive way.

At Sandymouth Bay fully trained and qualified instructors, with the support of school staff, provide instruction in a full programme of activities in a safe, controlled and secure environment. The cost of the trip will be £170.00, which includes return travel by coach, full board accommodation, a full programme of activities such as body boarding, climbing and abseiling. The cost also covers achievement certificates and comprehensive insurance.

Below are the dates for which interim and full payments will need to be received by for the trip. We will require payments by these dates in order to proceed with our booking through JCA. Should we not receive these amounts by the given dates we will assume that you no longer wish your child to take part in the Sandymouth Residential and sadly you will forfeit any monies paid up to that point.
